## RULES:

1. **No season pass required. If you choose not to purchase a season pass, you MUST pay at the gate to drop off or pick up your items and/or ribbons!**
2. Due to the early entry deadline, All Exhibitors will be required to pay entry fees on the total number of potential entries. On the day of the show, Monday August 31, 2026, all entries will be declared specifically as per the number of entries the exhibitor paid for. This will allow all exhibitors to show their best specimens at the time of the Fair.
3. All exhibits must be in place between **4 PM - 8 PM** on Monday, August 31, 2026 and picked up on the last day of Fair between 3 PM - 5 PM. Anything left after 5 PM will be thrown out.
4. Small grain should be in quart glass jars, furnished by the exhibitor. Grains and seeds shall be of this year or the preceding year.
5. For "stem" classes, typically about 3" of stem is left on the vegetable and leaves are not required.
