6. All breads to be in standard size loaf where loaf is designated. One slice will be left for exhibit after judging.
7. No commercial mixes.
8. Baked goods judged on Monday may be picked up after 12 PM to allow time to get samples ready for display. Exhibitor is responsible for picking up ribbons the last day of the fair and disposing of their displayed food items.

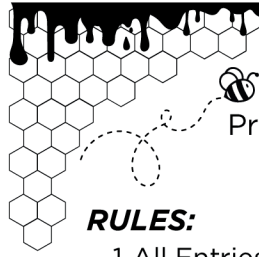

## RULES:

1. No duplicates in any class allowed.
2. All pies to be in aluminum foil pans. Please have pies cooled and in a 2 gallon zip locked bag with the entry tag firmly attached to top of the bag.
3. The finished pie may not contain raw/uncooked eggs (whites and/or yolks). Eggs must reach 160 degrees to be considered cooked.
4. Judging guidelines: General appearance of crust/topping; uniformity of browning; texture of crust; tenderness of filling; consistency of filling when cut; flavor; balance of ingredient flavors.
5. **A PIE MAY BE ENTERED ONLY ONE TIME. THE SAME EXHIBITOR MAY NOT USE THE SAME RECIPE YEAR AFTER YEAR.**
6. Pie must not be frozen at time of judging. **If frozen, pie will be disqualified and entry fee will not be refunded.**
7. Any items considered in-edible will be disqualified and entry fee will not be refunded.
